Roving Reporters

On Thursday 21st March, Mrs Ellerker came to teach Class 3 and 4 about First Aid. We learnt about what information an ambulance would need, including the address. We then looked at what to do if someone needed our help. Mrs Ellerker taught us about the 'DR ABC' primary survey and what each letter stands for.

D - Danger

R - Response

A - Airway

B - Breathing

C - Controlling bleeding

We learnt about how to put someone in the recovery position. Teddy volunteered and Mrs Elleker showed us what to do, step by step. We then got to try it on each other. After that, Mrs Ellerker taught us about how to treat a deep cut, using a padded bandage and a triangular bandage. We all really enjoyed the session and thought it was extremely kind of Mrs Ellerker to give up her own time to teach us these important skills.
