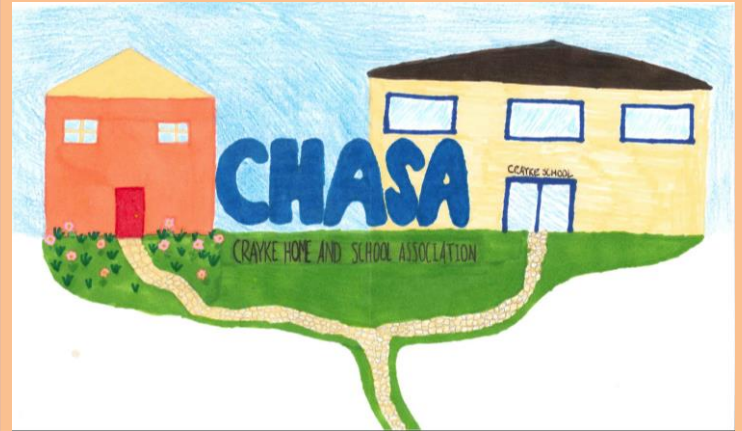

Where's Church this week?

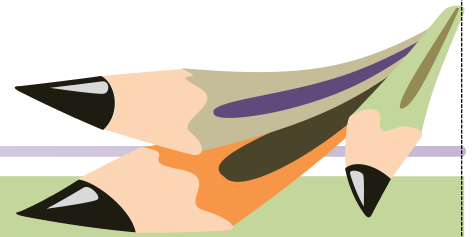
Sunday September 9th
