As you can see, this doesn't leave much room for manoeuvre in the event of staff being ill. Therefore, we wanted to give you advanced warning that there may be some occasions when due to unavoidable circumstances, children in some bubbles may be unable to attend school. We would always strive to provide as much notice of this as possible and we will notify you via the school website.

Some parents have been asking what the plans are to extend the opening of school to other year groups. At the moment, we have not been made formally aware by the government of a date for this to happen or which year groups this may extend to. We have been incredibly fortunate at Crayke that we have been able to accommodate the year groups required so far. However, it is important that you know that, should we be required to open to further year groups, we may need to alter the provision on offer to Reception, Year 1 and Year 6 as we simply don't have the physical space in the building to accommodate more children under the present requirements. We will review this as further information is made available to us and continue to communicate with you.

Key Stage 1 Fruit Scheme

We have made enquiries about the free fruit for children in Key Stage 1 and have been made aware that the scheme will not be running for the remainder of the summer term. We are currently investigating other options with regard to this and will provide more details as soon as we are able to. We are keen to be able to provide a playtime snack for children and to avoid parents needing to supply one.

School Lunches

Mrs Yates has been a super star and provided lovely packed lunches, in bags, for children in school this week. Mrs Bacon has taken a number of calls this week about the lunches so we thought it would be useful to remind you of the sandwich options each day, which are as follows:

Monday – sausage or egg

Tuesday – ham or cheese

Wednesday – chicken or tuna

Thursday – ham or cheese

Friday – chicken or tuna

Alongside the sandwich, there is a cold savoury snack, vegetable sticks, a piece of fruit, a cake/traybake and a carton of juice.
