Make a rain gauge

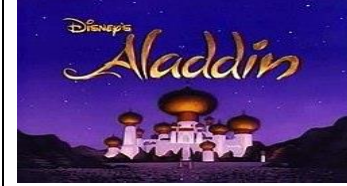


Talk about the importance of water in other countries, how they do not get their water from taps. How could we save water? Would you like to live in a country that did not have running water?
